Box 2 DECISION TAKEN:

To approve the use and allocation of £4,700 Section 106 funding from the balance of £9599.00 Section 106 monies held for Lyndale Avenue, Edenthorpe (06/02242/FULM) by way of a grant to Edenthorpe Parish Council, to fund the supply and installation of a 9mx9m base and granite sets around the existing monument at the above location which will be maintained by the Parish Council.

Box 3 REASON FOR THE DECISION:

The site has previously had an installation of a War Memorial funded by the community itself with permissions sought from Highways as appropriate. The memorial is the responsibility of the Parish Council. The installation has been on site for over a year and has become a focal point for remembrance in the village. The memorial has been registered on the national war memorial site.

The Council recognise the dedication of the community supported by the Parish Council in the raising of funds for the creation of a War Memorial in the area, which is also supported by both Elected Members.

A suitable funding agreement will be put in place with the Parish Council to ensure the funding is utilised as appropriate.

- 1. Do not allocate the funding This will result in the likelihood that the improvements will not be able to take place as other sources of funding have not been identified.
- 2. To contribute the funding, by way of a grant, to the Edenthorpe Parish Council to fund the proposed improvements to the existing monument to ensure the area is preserved around the monument
