## How will this contribute to improving health and wellbeing in Doncaster?

The strategy provides direction and a clear action plan for preventing people living in cold homes and reducing excess winter death incorporating the National Institute of Clinical Excellent recommendations. Once agreed the strategy will give guidance to partners and key holders and drive delivery of the Affordable Warmth program.

Cold homes and unaffordable fuel bills can lead to poor health for the most vulnerable people pensioners, the long-term sick or disabled, and young children. Fuel poverty affects one in ten households in England. NICE guidelines have recommended that England's 152 Health and Wellbeing Boards commission local 'single point of contact' housing and health referral service
