How will this contribute to improving health and wellbeing in Doncaster?

The production of the Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment (PNA) 2015-18 is one of the new duties of the Health and Wellbeing Board. It has been produced for Doncaster's Health and Wellbeing Board by Doncaster Council in conjunction with NHS England Area Team, Doncaster Clinical Commissioning Group, Doncaster Local Pharmaceutical Committee and the wider stakeholders and residents of Doncaster community.

This document is an assessment of the current provision of pharmaceutical services across Doncaster, whether they meet the needs of the population and identifies any potential gaps to service delivery.

Adequate pharmaceutical provision is essential for meeting the needs of the local population and is therefore a key component in ensuring the health and wellbeing needs of the population are met across Doncaster.
