Please find the attached e mail as notification that the South Yorkshire Police would seek to renew the Cumulative Impact Zone.

As you can see from the attached data Violent Crime within the zone has fallen by over 50 % over the last 6 months to September 2010, when compared with the same period in 2009. However the current trend is slightly upwards. This trend is skewed by a sharp rise in offending in August 2010.

Anti Social behaviour within the Town Centre rose slightly over the six months to Sept 2010. However in contrast incidents within the Cumulative Impact Zone fell over the same period.

It is imperative that if the Partnership is to reduce Violent Crime year on year that we are equipped with the necessary tools and powers, one of which is the Cumulative Impact Zone.

I am authorised by the Chief Constable of the South Yorkshire Police to represent him under the Licensing Act 2003. As such I would formally request that the Cumulative Impact Zone is maintained in its current form thus covering the following streets:-
