### APPLICATION FOR SEX ESTABLISHMENT LICENCE PLAYERS, 54 PRINTING OFFICE STREET, DONCASTER DN1 1TR

### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- 1. To request that members of the Committee determine the application for a Sex Establishment Licence in respect of premises at Players, 54 Printing Office Street, Doncaster.
- 2. The suggested procedure for considering the application is set out at Appendix A.

# EXEMPT REPORT

3. There are no confidential issues.

### RECOMMENDATIONS

4. That the Committee determine this application in accordance with the suggested procedure, having regard to the Policy adopted by the Authority and the evidence before it.

### BACKGROUND

- 5. Players is currently licensed under the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003 for sale of alcohol, late night refreshments and regulated entertainment, including adult entertainment, (ie pole dancing, lap dancing and nudity).
- Section 27 of the Policing and Crime Act 2009 introduced a new category of sex establishment called 'sexual entertainment venues' which allows licensing authorities to regulate lap dancing clubs and similar venues under Schedule 3 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provision) Act 1982 (as amended by Section 27 of the Policing and Crime Act 2009).

- 7. The new provisions were adopted by Doncaster Council and become effective on 15 January 2012, after which date a Sex Establishment Licence will be required to operate such premises. It is in accordance with these provisions that this application is made.
- 8. Representations have been received in respect of this application from a number of businesses and a church on Printing Office Street detailed at Appendix F.
- 9. The grant or refusal of the Sex Establishment Licence does not impact on the Premises Licence granted under provisions of the Licensing Act 2003, other than as relates to the provision of 'sexual entertainment'.
- 10. A summary of the application is attached as Appendix B to this report.
- 11. A copy of the application is attached at Appendix C.
- 12. The Applicant has certified that a copy of the application was sent to the South Yorkshire Police.
- 13. A site plan of the premises and the surrounding area is attached as Appendix D.

#### **OPTIONS CONSIDERED**

14. The Sexual Entertainment Venue Licensing Policy requires the Licensing Authority to exercise its obligations on all new licence applications, and the Licensing Authority requires a hearing in each case.

### **REASONS FOR RECOMMENDED OPTION**

15. The Sexual Entertainment Venue Licensing Policy requires the Licensing Authority to exercise its obligations on all new licence applications, and therefore no other option other than to hold a hearing can be considered.

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### **APPENDIX A**

#### GUIDANCE NOTE ON THE PROCEDURE FOR LICENSING COMMITTEE MEETINGS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING APPLICATIONS FOR A SEX ESTABLISHMENT LICENCE

This guidance note has been prepared to outline and help you to understand the procedure which will be followed at Doncaster Council's Licensing Committee meetings to make a decision on an application for a Sex Establishment Licence or where objections are received following an application to transfer, vary, or renew such licence.

The meeting will be conducted using the following procedure:-

- 1. The Chair will read an opening statement, which outlines the nature of the meeting.
- 2. The Chair will ask the Applicant, or his representative, to address the Committee on the application and the objections (if applicable).
- 3. The Applicant or his representative may then be asked questions by Members of the Committee or any objector (if applicable).
- 4. The Licensing Officer will address the Committee and the Applicant and ask/respond to any questions.
- 5. Where applicable, any objectors will be given an opportunity to address the Committee.
- 6. Where applicable, each objector may then be asked questions by Members of the Committee and the Applicant or his representative.
- 7. The Applicant will be asked to sum up and will have the last word.
- 8. The Applicant, any objectors and members of the press and public will leave the committee room.
- 9. The Committee will consider the matter and come to a decision and may seek the advice of the legal advisor. The function of the legal advisor shall be to advise the Committee on points of law and procedure only.
- 10. If during its deliberations, the Committee require any further information from any party in order to assist in its deliberations, the Chair shall reconvene the public hearing for the purpose of attempting to secure that further information.

11. Following the Committee's deliberations, the Applicant, any objectors and members of the press and public will be invited back into the committee room, whereupon the Chair of the Committee will announce the decision.

It is not possible to determine in advance the length of the meeting. However, the Chair will arrange for natural breaks to be taken at appropriate times during the proceedings
