### **Doncaster Council's Assets Portfolio**

Thank you for your letter of the 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2013 regarding the above. In response to the comments you raised in your letter, I can advise you as follows:-

### **Unadopted Roads**

Unadopted roads across the borough are not all owned by Doncaster Council. While some are the responsibility of the Council, a number remain in the ownership of private developers. I would suggest that if Members have questions relating to unadopted roads, they approach Gill Fairbrother in the first instance. Officers in Gill's team will then support Members in exploring the roads on a case by case basis to determine ownerships and responsibilities.

### **Register of Council Assets**

The Assets and Property Team are currently working with colleagues across other Directorates to develop a comprehensive list of assets to be made available for publication on the website and Intranet. While a full list of assets is available at the current time (as provided in the body of the report presented to the Scrutiny Panel), it is necessary that any published list is presented in an appropriate format. For example, it should not release details of Group Homes that the Council owns for supporting and/or safeguarding vulnerable residents. It is expected that we will be in a position to publish a list of assets on the website and Intranet towards the end of April 2013.


