Members of SACRE may know, but the Baha'i Faith is about to embark on a celebration of the 200 year anniversary of the birth of its founder (Baha'u'llah). As part of this celebration, the Baha'i community throughout the United Kingdom is offering schools the opportunity to show their students a short film that has been developed to mark this celebration and also bring some meaning to young people in today's society (irrespective of faith or none).

This short film is called 'Bahá'u'lláh - The Divine Physician'. The film shows young people from diverse backgrounds reflecting on the issues facing the world and the potential of the Baha'i teachings to address these issues. The film follows the daily activities of the young people and includes stories about Bahá'u'lláh and his teachings told through animated sequences.
