 Approve the outline delivery budget for these events of £275k delegated to the Director of Public Health from General Reserves.

Box 3 REASON FOR THE DECISION:

Through Doncaster Council's new cycling partnership with Welcome to Yorkshire, Doncaster has been selected as a host town for the 2018 Tour de Yorkshire. On the 3rd and 4th May 2018. Doncaster has also been selected to host a stage start of the UCI Road World Racing Championships in September of 2019. This is a major international cycling event second only to the Tour de France.

The financial package highlighted below was agreed as part of the Get Doncaster Cycling report approved by cabinet on the 9th of January 2018. This ODR is produced to formally record the sign off the delivery budget enabling the safe delivery of both events

It has been agreed in the report that a working budget of £275k is established to deliver the events with a notional break down of:

- £100k ASO Tour de Yorkshire host fee
- £75K 2018 Tour de Yorkshire host delivery
- £100k 2019 UCI worlds host delivery

Box 6 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

£275k is requested from general reserves for the forthcoming cycle races. As described in the body of the report, £100k is for the payment to the event organiser for the rights to host the Tour de Yorkshire, £75k is an estimate for the other costs of delivering the Tour de Yorkshire event and £100k is a prudent estimate of the costs of delivering the UCI worlds race event. As stated in the report the funding was approved at Cabinet on 9^{th} January, 2018.

There is no fee payable to the event organiser for hosting the UCI race.

The delivery cost estimates have been based upon the costs of delivering the 2016 Doncaster stage finish of the Tour de Yorkshire, with a reduction for reusing equipment and lessons learned. It is also anticipated that further staffing resources will be required to assist with backfill at busy times but these arrangements have not yet been

finalised so costs cannot be calculated.

There may be a further requirement to request funding depending upon the outcome of these discussions.
