Box 2 DECISION TAKEN:

To accept £38,529.00 of SUEZ funding to purchase and install the second phase of Woodland Adventure Play in Sandall Park; include the project in the R & E Capital Programme; and approve draw down of the overall £38,529.00 budget to commence delivery subject to the receipt of appropriate terms and conditions of the SUEZ Grant.

Box 3 REASON FOR THE DECISION:

Give relevant background information

In December 2017, Doncaster Council, in partnership with the Friends of Sandall Park, submitted an application to SUEZ for funding towards an extension to the popular Woodland Adventure Play to be installed in Sandall Park at a cost of circa maximum £38,529.00. We were successful in this application and SUEZ is prepared to pay £38,529.00 of grant towards the costs of the project.

The payment to SUEZ Communities Trust of £4,431 from section 106 monies has been made as a contribution to enable the release of funding to a supported project. A payment which is called the Contributing Third party (CTP) payment.

We now need to decide to accept the funding and implement the project.

The terms of the grant are very favourable, and give us an opportunity to do something that would not be possible otherwise.

We could decide not to accept the grant, but there are no other resources available so the scheme would have to be cancelled, and this would run contrary to considerable expectation from both the very active Friends Of Sandall Park group and senior management that the scheme will go ahead.

The Council's Financial Procedure Rules provide that external funding of less than £50,000 is acceptable within the financial year provided that the relevant Director is responsible for informing the Chief Financial Officer, promptly, about such funding and of any subsequent modifications to timing and amounts of anticipated funding.

Box 6 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

Capital

The cost of the scheme to install a second phase to the Woodland Adventure Park at Sandal Park is estimated to be £38,529 including VAT with the exclusion of any contingency being allocated for this project.

This will be funded from: -

• £38,529 SUEZ Community Trust funding, with approval to accept this grant requested as part of this ODR.

To enable the Authority to secure the funding, an up-front contribution of £4,431 has been made by Adults and communities (ODR Decision AHWB/021/2018) from S106 contributions.

Should any overspend occur on the project this will need to be found from the Street scene revenue budget.

The project is capital in nature and will be a new addition to the R & E Capital Programme, which requires approval by the CFO and service Director, in consultation with the relevant Portfolio Holder. Any changes will be reported to Cabinet on a quarterly basis.

The value of the SUEZ funding applied is below £50,000, with conditions attached, so a business case does not need to be approved by the Management Team to accept the Grant (financial procedure rule E10). However, acceptance of the Grant is still subject to agreement with SUEZ terms and conditions. The Funding Agreement has been received and subject to both Financial and Legal assessment. Financial assessment is that risk is minimal providing there are no changes to the scope and nature of the project.

On approval of the report, the Capital Programme will be updated to include this project and a capital sub cost centre will be created and allocated for the projects use.

<u>Revenue</u>

Ongoing maintenance will be included as part of the Street scene service scheduled maintenance and contained within existing Street scene budgets.
