It is subject to conditions restricting its operation to a maximum of 3 employees and opening only between 9 -5 Monday to Friday and not any other time.</p> <p>The times requested in the license application are contrary to the times allowed in the planning permission, this includes evenings and weekends, which if permitted would be in breach of the planning conditions.</p> <p>The premises is in a confined area and close to the boundary of residential properties and it was considered that to operate the site at anti-social times would harm the amenities of adjacent occupiers by reason of loss of amenity through noise and disturbance and additional comings and goings.</p> <p>Therefore the Planning Department as a 'responsible authority' would object if a license were to be granted that permitted sales outside the hours allowed by the planning permission.</p> <p>Please note that representations should be confined to matters which are about the likely effect of the grant of the licence on the promotion of the licensing objectives.
