Illicit tobacco products have been sold from Bargain Beers, 248 Balby Road.

Sale of illicit tobacco products is a criminal offence.

Illicit tobacco products are not made to the same standards as legitimate tobacco products and do not incorporate the safety features required by the Regulations. In particular, cigarettes made in this way lack the capacity to self-extinguish. They have been implicated in house fires.

During the investigation into the sale of illicit tobacco products issues relating to the Premises Licence itself have been discovered.

On 10/09/2018 a test purchase was made from Bargain Beers of Rothmans 20s cigarettes. The cigarettes were not in standardised "plain" packaging and the health warnings and other information on the packaging was in a language other than English, in breach of the Regulations. The packaging did not bear the mark "UK Duty Paid" indicating that they were smuggled.

On 25/09/2018 a second test purchase was made from Bargain Beers of Rothmans 20s cigarettes. The cigarettes again did not comply with the Regulations and did not have UK duty applied.

On 28/09/2018 a seizure of 67 packets of illicit cigarettes was made. The packaging did not comply with the Regulations and did not have UK duty applied. One of the brands seized was counterfeit.

During the inspection a check of the Premises Licence was made, and the following non-compliances were discovered. Lomza lager beer and Kozel lager beer were on sale. The items did not have the ingredients labelled in English as required by the Regulations, so the presence of allergens in the products could not be determined. No invoices could be provided to show from where these products were supplied. This suggests that these alcohol products are in fact smuggled.

The CCTV could not be reviewed.

No incident book was kept.

The premises themselves have been extended significantly but there has not been any application to vary the Premises Licence. The building work has not been safely completed, with electrical sockets hanging off the wall in a public area. No electrical conformance certificate has been supplied.
