1. DECISION TITLE

COVID-19 pressures funding of £10.09m, Hardship Fund of £2.99m and the Mayors 10-point action plan.

2. DECISION TAKEN

Notes the receipt of £10.09m from the COVID-19 Pressures funding from central government and £2.99m being the Council's allocation from the Hardship Fund

Delegates to the Chief Executive in consultation with the Mayor future decision making regarding the design and implementation of the programmes to deliver the 10-point action plan.

Approves the addition of the balance of the £2.99m Hardship Fund to the £10.09m emergency funding as described below.

3. REASON FOR URGENCY

This decision is being taken under Special Urgency provisions to enable the Council to accept and utilise the £10.09m Emergency Covid Funding and the £2.99m Hardship Fund, to respond to the COVID 19 pandemic and deliver the Mayor's 10 point action plan. Delegation to the Chief Executive around the design and implementation of the programmes will enable the Council to respond quickly to the needs of individuals and communities and shape the delivery of services as required. This decision will ensure the Council can continue to deliver services and seek to safeguard the most vulnerable in our communities.

4. REASONS FOR DECISION

Use of the £10.09m of emergency fund and £2.99m Hardship Fund will enable the Council to take actions in support of COVID-19 and to provide help to the vulnerable and those who support them, and those affected by the economic slowdown caused by the lockdown.
