## **Doncaster Community Fund Ward Member Budget 2021/22 Approval of Applications**

Further to the establishment of a ward Members Budget of up to £3k per Councillor a number of applications have been received and assessed in line with the application criteria and supported by the relevant ward Councillor (s).

### **Legal Considerations:**

Section 236 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 provides that an authority may make arrangements for individual Members to exercise functions of the authority in relation to the electoral division or ward for which the Member is elected.

In implementing the scheme and agreeing grant applications the Council must ensure this is in accordance with its Financial Procedure Rules. Any parties accepting the grant must formally agree to the terms and conditions of the grant funding. Appropriate monitoring of activities and expenses will be undertaken where necessary to ensure compliance. Councillor Nevett and Robinson have both declared their interests as

Trustees of Glass Park and have complied with her obligations under the law and the Member Code of Conduct and this does not prevent the grant being awarded.

#### **Financial Considerations**

The Elected Members Ward Budget is included the 2021/22 Revenue Budget. Within this allocation each elected Member is allocated up to £3k (£165k in total across all 55 elected Members) to support local groups and organisations.

A central record of grants allocated will be maintained by the Corporate Governance Team within Legal and Democratic Services – this will reconcile to the grant payments made and record the outcomes achieved through the use of the grant funding.

This is an allocation of existing 2021/22 revenue budget and so is contained within the Council's current budget envelope.

The individual applications below, detail the extent to which the initiative will seek to make a positive impact within the local community.

Glass Park Forest School (Wildlings and Wellbeing) Reference No: 39/DCF/21-22/E&KS

**Supported by: Councillors Nevett and Robinson** 

Cost £425

EXPECT Youth will support Wildlings and Wellbeing to deliver four, 2 hour Forest Schools sessions in the Glass Park, Kirk Sandall. This will include bug hunting, pond dipping, nature craft and mud kitchen for children aged 5 to 11 (and potentially older siblings). A Halloween Themed session which includes potion making, pumpkins, hammocks, Autumn crafts and bug hunting for the same age group. The sessions will be provided free for participants.

The funding will be put towards staff costs for the sessions, to ensure children are kept safe at all times.

EXPECT Youth will support the activity with organising and promoting the activity through it's networks, website and social media, encouraging local people to apply via the schools, local groups and specialist providers (social workers, health visitors, SEND contacts).


