

COVID Update: Doncaster and other areas




Doncaster rates per 100,000 for period 14-20 August 2022:

60+ year old: 57.6 / 100,000


ONS prevalence for Yorkshire and the Humber: 2.6%

COVID cases in Doncaster by settings (31/08/2022)



Winter Plan: Autumn COVID-19 booster and flu vaccine programme

Letter from NHS England dated 18 August 2022: people who will be offered a COVID-19 booster vaccine:

- residents in a care home for older adults and staff working in care homes for older adults
- > frontline health and social care workers
- ➤ all adults aged 50 years and over
- persons aged 5 to 49 years in a clinical risk group, as set out in the Green Book
- persons aged 5 to 49 years who are household contacts of people with immunosuppression
- >persons aged 16 to 49 years who are carers, as set out in the Green Book.

Winter Plan: Autumn COVID-19 booster and flu vaccine programme (2)

- Co-administration: maximise opportunities to co-promote and co-administer vaccinations where possible and clinically advised (eg COVID-19, flu and pneumococcal)
- Campaign start and invites: the flu programme will begin as usual from 1 September with sites vaccinating when locally procured vaccine allows. Visits to care homes will begin from w/c 5 September with formal launch of the winter/autumn campaign on 12 September.
- Campaign completion: in order to optimise protection for people, systems should offer vaccination by the start of December.
- Doncaster Council will be offering flu vaccination to ALL staff
