1. AGENDA ITEM NUMBER AND TITLE

Humber 2100+ Strategy and Flood Risk Management Plans

2. DECISION TAKEN

It is recommended to accept the findings of the Humber 2100+ stage 1 modelling outputs and adopt and implement the Flood Risk Management Plan.

3. REASONS FOR DECISION

The reasons for recommending this option is to ensure our decision making is in keeping with existing Council policy and other wider strategies. The recommended option supports the objectives of the Local Flood Risk Management Strategy (adopted July 2014), primarily Objective 2 'To improve understanding of local flood risk within the LLFA and to other partners and stakeholders'. The recommended option will also support Doncaster's contribution to the Connected by Water Action Plan, particularly Theme 4 – Communication, Engagement and Building Resilience.

4. ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED AND REJECTED

The only alternative option that was considered was to defer the decision to a later date to allow greater scrutiny of the decision. This option was discounted as it would severely impact the delivery programme of both the FRMPs and the Humber 2100+ strategy. Without the FRMPs being implemented, the communities would remain at risk whilst further scrutiny

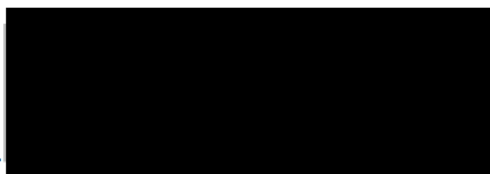
