The money will be spent on providing basic craft supplies for the families that attend the group and to replace broken games as the year progresses.

Councillor Blackham and Councillor Durant have complied with their obligations under the law and the Member Code of Conduct and this does not prevent the grant being awarded.

### **Financial Considerations**

The Elected Members Ward Budget is included the 2022/23 Revenue Budget. Within this allocation each elected Member is allocated up to £3k (£165k in total

across all 55 elected Members) to support local groups and organisations.

A central record of grants allocated will be maintained by the Corporate Governance Team within Legal and Democratic Services – this will reconcile to the grant payments made and record the outcomes achieved through the use of the grant funding.

This is an allocation of existing 2022/23 revenue budget and so is contained within the Council's current budget envelope.
