BOX 3

REASON FOR THE DECISION

Please see below table detailing requests for price increases from several Providers who deliver provision for out of authority day education placements or residential school placements. This request is for one financial year from the 1^{st of} September 2023.

The increase request relates to cost of off framework placements. The current contract for these placements permits inflationary increases subject to a consideration of the actual costs incurred by the Provider and the need for value for money justification.

The provider has demonstrated to the Council justification for such increases citing various reasons which generally relate to unavoidable cost pressures of inflation, National Living Wage increase, National Insurance increase and pension costs. Should these increases not be agreed there is a risk that the placements will no longer be sustainable and new provision would need to be sourced.

New placements would need to be sourced for the children and young people being affected in a difficult and challenging market with high demand and low availability of placements.
